



Rose Black Spot & Insect Spray

Sharp Shooter

- Convenient combination of fungicide and pesticide
- Broad Spectrum - kills and controls a wide range of pests
- Does not persist in the environment
- Lack of insect immunity
- Systemic - gets into sap stream of plant

Controls Pests: Aphids, Thrips, Caterpillars, Whitefly, Bud worm and Two Spotted Mite

Controls Diseases: Black Spot, Powdery Mildew and Rust

For use on: Roses (all types), Ornamentals (shrubs, flowering annuals and perennials)

When to use: Spray whenever disease is visible, also start an early preventative spray program at the beginning of Spring once foliage emerges



Black spot is the main problem gardeners have with their roses, this product provides an environmentally friendly treatment by combining a systemic fungicide and insecticide together, and therefore is an efficient means of controlling both insect pests and fungus disease. The fungicide in Sharp Shooter Rose Spray, is systemic in action. This means the active ingredient passes through the plant tissues and fights the target diseases from inside the plant. Natural Pyrethrum and Tau-fluvalinate are low toxicity insecticides that controls or suppresses the pests when foliage is ingested.
